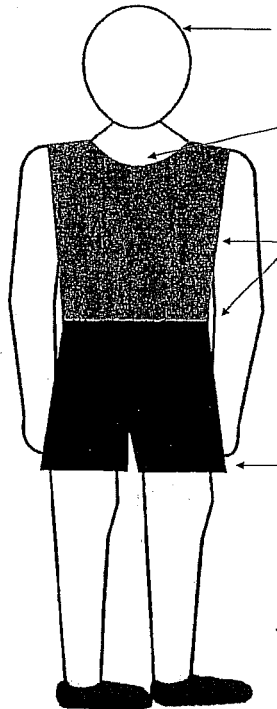


Twin Falls Middle School Dress Code



Our goal is to show respect for the learning environment and to alleviate distractions in the classrooms. Modesty, neatness, and cleanliness are requested as a part of the dress code. Consequences may include being asked to change clothing, cover up, or go home if necessary.



Heads: TFMS students must remove all headgear in the building.

Necklines: low cut blouses, tops, sweater, etc. with plunging necklines are not allowed.

Torso: Clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence, is sexually suggestive or displays inappropriate pictures or writing is prohibited.

Legs: Shorts, skirts and dresses must be longer than mid-thigh.

Guidelines

Includes hats, hoods, bandana, sweatbands and head-wraps (exceptions will be made for medical, religious, and other approved reasons)

Clothing must cover stomachs, backs, shoulders, chests, and undergarments while standing, sitting, bending, or reaching

Any clothing worn in a manner that may be identified as gang related is prohibited.

Jewelry or other accessories that may pose a safety hazard is prohibited.

Exceptions to dress code standards may be made for PE or school activities
